

Butterfly Card



Required

- ☑ Stamps – Clock; Butterflies; butterfly quote
- ☑ Card – Blue(A5); White (A6)
- ☑ Flourish Bling Pack
- ☑ Piece of clear plastic or acetate
- ☑ Blending tool and pads
- ☑ Ink Pads – Distress – Broken China; Spiced Marmelade
- Embossing
 - Stazon – Black
- ☑ Clear Embossing Powder
- ☑ Alcohol Inks – Denim; Sunshine Yellow
- ☑ Ice Sticks

Instructions

- ☑ Fold Blue card in half to form base. Trim white card to fit on the front with a border of blue.
- ☑ Prepare white card for embossing with an anti-static pad then stamp over the bottom right corner with the clock stamp and embossing ink. Apply clear embossing powder and heat set.
- ☑ Use the blender tool and spiced marmalade and rub ink into the centre of the white card, blending it out towards two of the corners. Fill in the remaining white space with a new blending pad and the denim ink.
- ☑ Spritz whole card with water and re-blend to soften any edges.

- ☐ Stamp the butterfly quote on the bottom left of the card with the Stazon ink.
- ☐ Stamp the butterflies image onto a sheet of plastic and turn over. Drop a couple of drops of the alcohol ink onto the butterflies and leave to dry. Cut each butterfly out and gently bend up the wings.
- ☐ Adhere each butterfly to the card wherever you prefer, add ice stickles to the wings.
- ☐ Finally, cut up some of the bling bits and add to the butterflies.
