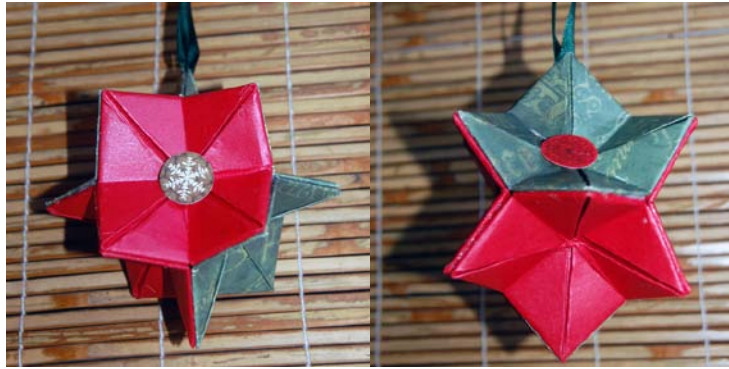


Christmas Ornament

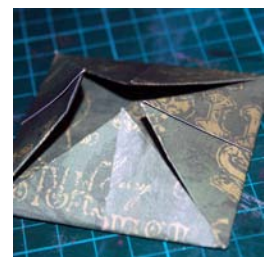
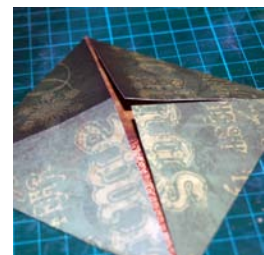


You will need...

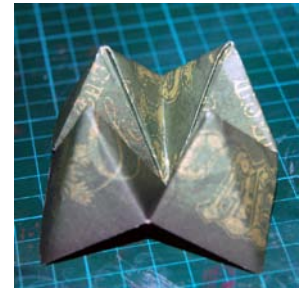
- 3 pieces of plain card cut into 6 by 6 inch squares
- 3 pieces of patterned paper cut into 6 by 6 inch squares
- 15cm length of ribbon
- Decorative items

To Create...

1. Begin by ensuring each square is exactly 6 inch by 6 inch. This is important or they will not fold accurately.
2. Beginning with the first square, fold it in half and then in half again to create score marks.
3. Fold each square in so that the corner touches the centre of the folds. Ensure the right side of your patterned paper is on the outside at this stage.
4. Flip the whole piece over and repeat step 3. With card type paper this may take some time as there are several layers to fold through.



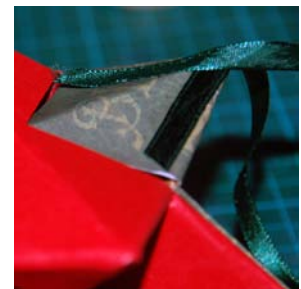
5. Turn over once more and carefully pull out flaps and mould into a chatterbox shape. Repeat to create 6 chatterboxes altogether.



6. Using the finger flap sections, begin gluing each chatterbox together so that the folded side is facing out on your ornament.



7. Continue gluing all the chatterboxes together until you have all but one joined together. Glue both ends of the ribbon to one of the flaps to create a ribbon loop for hanging your ornament. Glue in the last chatterbox.



8. Decorate by adding a button or sticker to the centre of each chatterbox to complete.
